- 2020 - 2021 School Calendar has changed one Pro D Day. No changes to bell Schedule.
 - School fees changed slightly. Trip costs have increased. IB fees restructured to include IB exam fees.
 - School Plan - put on hold for now.
 - September Restart Plan - Parents will receive survey next week asking for their opinions, suggestions from June school re-opening to improve September school start.
 - June school attendance was at 20% daily. Next stage would be 40% for Sept.
 - Preparing to scale from 10-40%, possibly 50%.
 - Timetable almost done. Counsellors will work with students next week to resolve conflicts.
 - Numeracy Assessment was provided for Grade 12s to graduate.
 - Yearbook pickup, return books, uniforms, library books, clean out lockers. Grad gown pickup for grad event next week.
 - Student Council elections online now.

- Minister of Education - marks will be no lower than if school ended on March 13th.

- Summer School - can register for 2 subjects, times unknown.
- Grad - virtual video would be available for people to view after June 25.
- Formal Artona grad picture taken on June 22 and 23.
- Physical distancing restrictions to continue in September. Classes in the morning in school, will be supplemental to online learning. No more than 50% students at any time in the school.
- Sports - BC School Sports suspended all Athletics for now.
- Anti-Racism program - School District policy - examine practices, anti-racist curriculum and environment. Includes any kind of discrimination, e.g., religion.
- More hands-on classes may be difficult in September.
- No staffing issues
- 40% in class students - school admin will make the groups.
- Clubs Day. Online activities possible.
- Grade 8 Welcome to Churchill video made by Student Council. Tour and visit will be set up at a later date by school admin.
- IB Hybrid model - Arrange for Flex time for their schedule.
- Band program - try to set up physically distant playing.
- School office to remain open during summer
- If Math and French placement tests for Grade 8 could not be done, the placements will be done based on recommendations
- IB exams may will be accommodated.
- Lectures recorded and available online, will not be provided in person
- Synergy & Prelude outdoor activities - wait for decision
- Grade 11 IB camp - wait for decision
